F1 STARS BAKE APPLE STRUDEL & FANS VISIT PIT LANE

Max Verstappen has already won the Austrian Grand Prix five times - more than any other driver in Formula 1 history. The "six-pack" at Red Bull Racing's home race is within reach, as is an exciting battle for full championship points. The starting signal was given on Thursday at Spielberg. The fans warmed up for the race weekend at the Pit Lane Walk and the stars of the premier class have arrived in the Mur Valley. The side-event fireworks will continue seamlessly on Friday, with the sprint qualifying being the first highlight on the race track. Teams, drivers and above all the fans enjoy the atmosphere at the Red Bull Ring with the red-white-red accents that have made the Austrian GP so special for many years. Visitors started the race weekend with the traditional Pit Lane Walk with insights into the sanctuaries of motorsport's premier class. In the paddock, the popular "Spielberg tractor" made its rounds with hearty music and regional delicacies. The figureheads of the Austrian F1 team, Max Verstappen and Sergio Pérez, familiarized themselves with the local cuisine in the patisserie of the Red Bull Ring and prepared their first real apple strudel.

Friday highlights on the Grand Prix circuit and in the Fan Zones. On Friday morning, ARAS will thrill fans with its freestyle motorcycle stunt show before they can experience their idols up close at the "Meet the Drivers" (from 10:35 a.m.) in the F1 Fan Zone. The first lap times will be etched into the Austrian asphalt during F1 training (12:30) and the starting grid for the sprint will be determined at 16:30. Bands in the Steiermark Village, such as Wolkenlos, Berglandpower and Die Aufgeiger, as well as live acts in the F1 Fan Zone, such as Yarden Saxophone vs Marisha Music vs Elli AK, Öwnboss and Fedde le Grand, will provide the atmosphere on Friday evening.
