## MAX IS "ON FIRE" – POLE FOR AUSTRIAN GP 2024

Formula 1 Qatar Airways Großer Preis von Österreich | Max Verstappen qualifies ahead of Lando Norris and George Russell | Legends Parade "Austrian GP Winners" | 50 fans perform national anthem

**The best Formula 1 driver of the moment takes the next decisive step on the way to his Red Bull Racing team's sixth home win at Spielberg. Max Verstappen took pole position ahead of Britons Lando Norris (McLaren) and George Russell (Mercedes). The racing driver icons of the Legends Parade 2024 have familiarized themselves with their glorious cars and will provide the side event highlight before the start of the race on Sunday. **Legends Parade "Austrian GP Winners"**. On Saturday evening, five Formula 1 icons familiarized themselves with the Red Bull Ring at the dress rehearsal for the Legends Parade 2024. Half a century of motorsport history will be brought to life at the ninth edition of this side-event highlight on GP Sunday (12:30 pm). The celebrity line-up ranges from Emerson Fittipaldi to Gerhard Berger, who will be in Michael Schumacher's 2002 Ferrari. Max Verstappen's RB14 (2018, first home win for Red Bull Racing) and Ronnie Peterson's 1978 Lotus are on display in the F1 Fan Zone.

**The "anthem of a lifetime" for 50 F1 fans.** Another dress rehearsal took place on Saturday evening: Martin Grubinger practiced with the winners of the Anthem Challenge for the musical effort of a lifetime. Shortly before the start of the race, 50 Formula 1 fans and the MyGroove Allstars will perform "Land of the Mountains" in the version by Hollywood legend Hans Zimmer. On the way to the race track on Sunday (08:30 to 11:00), the drivers and team bosses will make a stopover in front of the Welcome Center, sign autographs and also have time for souvenir photos.
