FANS AND WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP STARS CELEBRATE MotoGP-PARTY AT THE RED BULL RING

Anyone who knows Spielberg knows what to expect around Austria's motorsport highlight of the year: the best atmosphere, a unique atmosphere in the middle of the Styrian mountains, first-class racing action and, of course, a top-class supporting programme. When the MotoGP stars pitch their tents at the Red Bull Ring in two weeks' time, the carpet has already been rolled out for the fans. All the popular side events will accompany the race weekend from Thursday to Sunday and there will be a few extra treats. From the Pit Lane Walk to live concerts in the MotoGP Bike City, fan wishes will be fulfilled. Based on the Olympic motto: You simply have to be there! The prelude to the event – "MopedGP" and Pit Lane Walk. The Motorcycle World Championship traditionally kicks off on Thursday at the Red Bull Ring with the Pit Lane Walk. August 15th is dedicated to an exclusive stroll through the pit lane with insights into the teams' sanctuaries. The MotoGP stars are also aware of this and spontaneously surprise their fans with their first selfies or autographs. Weekend ticketholders have access, but due to the limited number of visitors, "first come, first served" applies. This year, there will be an extra treat on Thursday: before the traditional kick-off, a premiere will be celebrated with the first "MopedGP of Austria", where hundreds of moped riders will ring in the race weekend and can be cheered on by spectators in the open grandstands.

World Championship stars up close. From Thursday, the MotoGP Bike City will welcome its first visitors at its regular location behind the Niki Lauda corner and the gates will be open until Sunday evening. The side-event Eldorado is once again the central point of contact for the enthusiastic public when it comes to autographs and souvenir photos. At "Meet the Riders", the World Championship stars - MotoGP, Moto2, Moto3 – will be meeting the fans from Thursday to Saturday. There will be additional opportunities for selfies with the idols on Saturday and Sunday mornings at the "Hero Walk on the Styrian Green Carpet" in front of the Red Bull Ring Welcome Center.

Live concerts & trial bike shows in the MotoGP Bike City. After the action on the GP track, the MotoGP Bike City is the place to be for live concerts. Austrian chart-topper Alexander Eder and Graz-based dialect pop combo Granada will take to the stage on Friday. Granada's second big performance of the weekend will be on Sunday, when the musicians will perform the national anthem on the start-finish straight before the start of the race. Before that, on Saturday, the cover bands "U2 TRIBUTE - Achtung Babies" and "KISS FOREVER" will provide a festival feeling in the area behind the Niki Lauda Curve. The Adrian Guggemos Trial Stuntshows will amaze fans with two different settings. So, if you still don't have a ticket, you should get one now – preferably for the whole weekend, including the chance to take part in the Pit Lane Walk.
